

Kamp Dels enforces the following rules for the benefit of all our guests. If you have any questions or problems, please notify us at the barn. We are here to serve you and want you to have an enjoyable stay.

- ** All guests must register before entering the campground. Visiting hours are over at 11:00 PM.
- ** Small campfires in areas identified only. No stone fire rings. Do not cut or use wood found on campground. You may bring your own firewood or purchase some from the General Store.
- ** No lifeguard on duty at the pools. Children must be accompanied by an adult. Swimmers must wear swim wear. No cutoffs or swimming in clothes.
- ** Waterpark: Kids 2-17 yrs are required to wear a wristband. Available at the office.
- ** For the enjoyment of everyone, Kamp Dels strictly enforces quiet hours 11:00 p.m. to 8 a.m. All campfires must be out by 1 a.m. Children must remain at their site during quiet hours unless accompanied by an adult. For everyone's safety, no bike riding after dark.
- ** Loud and excessive noise is not allowed at any time. Radios and TV sets allowed at low volumes only, and are not permitted during quiet hours. Running of generators is not permitted. No kegs allowed. No alcohol use by minors is permitted.
- ** All sites must be kept in a neat and litter free condition. Please take your trash to one of the many dumpsters located on the grounds.
- ** The use of firearms, fire works, BB guns, slingshots, or other weapons is prohibited.
- ** Property adjoining the campground is private property. Please do not trespass. This includes the fields north of the campground.

- ** Speed limit on campground roads is 5 MPH. No motorbikes or battery-operated toy vehicles are allowed driven in the resort.
 - ** No fish cleaning allowed on the sites. You must use the fish house at the east end of the grounds. Do not put remains in the dumpsters.
 - ** Pets are allowed but you must observe the following rules. You must not leave your pet at your site when no one is there. Your pet must be on a leash at all times, and they can't be tied to trees. You must clean up after your pet, and barking dogs are not allowed. Dogs are not allowed at the pools.
 - ** Checkout time is 2 p.m. On Sundays, or for the last day of a holiday weekend, checkout time is 4 p.m.
 - ** Do not tie your boat to our docks or racks. 10 min. temporary tie ups are allowed. You may pull or tie your boat on shore.
 - ** To help save our grass, all tents, rugs, tarps, or any other item which may smother the grass, must be moved to a new location every 3 days.
 - ** Sewer dump station is located north of our petting zoo. No gray water is allowed to be dumped on the ground. Do not dump porta-potties in restrooms.
 - ** Skateboarding is allowed, only as a mode of transportation- NO horseplay.
- The management reserves the right to evict anyone without refund who does not follow our rules.*
